**** SHOW RULES AND REGULATIONS ****

1. Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current Vermont Horse Shows Association, USEF (for Morgan classes), and AQHA (for Quarter Horse classes) rulebooks and will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith. Specifications for those classes not listed in the VHSA or USEF rulebooks are on the next page. **Exhibitors are responsible for knowing the requirements and specifications of the classes they enter.** CVHS/VQHA is not responsible if exhibitors are disqualified or penalized by the judge or steward for using unconventional/incorrect tack or attire for the class. Please visit the CVHS website for links to the VHSA, USEF Morgan, and AQHA rulebooks.
2. Shows will run rain or shine. In the case of severe weather (torrential rain, lightning, etc) the show will be moved to the indoor.
3. **REQUIRED EQUINE PAPERWORK** – Exhibitors MUST PROVIDE A COPY of current Rabies vaccination and Coggins test dated within one year of date of show. If entering Quarter Horse or Morgan classes you MUST PROVIDE A COPY of the horse's registration papers. Out of state horses must have a Certificate of Veterinary Inspection dated within 30 days available. *There is a \$2 copy fee per page if copies of the required documents are not provided.*
4. **AQHA CLASSES** – *new this year! Support your local shows and get AQHA/VQHA points! Exhibitors must provide a copy of the horse's registration papers and a copy of your AQHA membership card. Exhibitors will be charged an AQHA processing fee of \$4 per horse to compete in AQHA classes.*
5. **ENTRY FEES** - Six ribbons awarded in every class. All classes are \$8 each pre-entry or \$10 each post-entry. Exhibitors may also pre-enter by using the online entry form listed on the CVHS or VQHA website (pre-payment is not required for online entries for this show). There is no refund for scratched classes. Championship classes will be awarded a payback according to how many are in the class. See class list for payback chart. Exhibitors must come to the Secretary's booth to collect any cash prizes. Show management reserves the right to pay out prize money via check. Failure of exhibitor to pick up their cash prize by the end of the show day will result in forfeiture. Returned checks charged \$30.
6. **PAYMENT/REFUNDS TERMS** – Cash or check. Checks may be deposited upon receipt. NO REFUNDS UNLESS ILLNESS OR INJURY WITH NOTE FROM DOCTOR/VET SUBMITTED TO MANAGEMENT BY NOON THE FOLLOWING TUESDAY.
7. **STALLS** - There is no overnight stabling available. Exhibitors traveling from a distance may drive up the night before and leave their horse securely in their trailer overnight AT THEIR OWN RISK. A list of local stables that may have stalls available will be posted on the website mid-June.
8. Exhibitors may school their horses in the practice ring. Measuring area will be posted at the entry stand.
9. **ARRIVAL/REMOVAL OF HORSES** – Exhibitors may arrive anytime that morning or previous evening and must be removed within 2 hours of the show's conclusion.
10. We are offering a lot of classes and need your help to keep the show running smoothly. When a class has lined up, the next class will enter the ring and walk on the rail. Exhibitors failing to enter the ring once the gate is closed and class has been called to order by the judge will not be allowed to show in the class. Tack holds must be requested prior to class. **No refunds for failing to enter the ring on time OR not completing your trail class before it closes.** Please plan your day accordingly.
11. Dogs must be leashed or tied at all times. CVHS, Jolley Stables, AQHA, and VQHA accept no responsibility for injuries sustained by any animal on the show grounds. Rabies tags may be checked. Please keep dogs away from riding rings.
12. **MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO:** Add to or vary the list of invited officials; decline or refuse any entry without being held liable; eliminate from further competition any exhibitor or equine should the best interest of the show be served; not delay classes due to conflicts; not to allow substitutions of animals or classes; change the order of classes before or during the show; combine, divide, or cancel classes. Should any questions or disputes arise not provided for in the foregoing rules, they shall be referred to the show steward whose decision shall be final.
13. The judge's decision is final. No person shall approach the judge without the approval of show management.
14. No entry will be permitted in the ring unless they have signed an entry form and fees for that class have been paid or a signed open check is left with the Secretary. Exhibitors will be disqualified if numbers are not clearly visible either on the exhibitor's back or on both sides of the saddle. Parent/guardian must sign if exhibitor is 18 and under.

**** DEFINITION OF DIVISIONS ****

Ages are as of January 1st, 2012 Exhibitors must show in same division all year regardless if your age changes.

VHSA RULE - ALL EQUINES BEING SHOWN UNDER SADDLE MUST BE AT LEAST 3 YEARS OLD (born in 2009).

Beginner – 12 and under, walk, trot/jog only, all seats

Novice Rider – 13 and over, walk, trot/jog only, all seats

Green Horse/Pony – equines 3 years and over in 1st or 2nd year of showing. Walk and trot/jog only, all seats.

Junior – ages 13 and under, walk, trot/jog, canter/lope

Senior – ages 14-18, walk, trot/jog, canter/lope

Adult – ages 19 and over, walk, trot/jog, canter/lope

Miniature Horse – any equine 38" and under

Quarter Horse – any registered Quarter Horse

Morgan – any registered Morgan

****AQHA Novice Youth** – 18 & under, walk, trot/jog, canter/lope

****AQHA Youth** – 18 & under, walk, trot/jog, canter/lope

****AQHA Novice Amateur** – 19 & over, walk, trot/jog, canter/lope

****AQHA Amateur** – 19 & over, walk, trot/jog, canter/lope,

AQHA Open – any AQHA member, walk, trot/jog, canter/lope

*****Exhibitors in AQHA Novice and Amateur divisions must qualify for those divisions according to AQHA rules.***

**** CLASS SPECIFICATIONS ****

Quarter Horse Showmanship Open & AQHA Showmanship Classes – Western attire only. No whips or bridles. Exhibitors will be worked individually from the gate. Exhibitors are scored from 0-100 with 70 denoting an average performance. Judged on exhibitor's poise, confidence, appearance and position throughout the class, as well as the horse's overall body condition, fitness, and cleanliness. See AQHA rulebook for further details. Not VHSA rated.

AQHA Halter Classes – Horses will walk to the judge one at a time. As the horse approaches, the judge will step to the right (left of the horse) to enable the horse to trot straight to a cone placed 50 feet (15 meters) away. At the cone, the horse will continue trotting, turn to the left and trot toward the left wall or fence of the arena. After trotting, horses will be lined up head to tail for individual inspection by the judge. The judge shall inspect each horse from both sides, front and rear. Rating conformation depends upon objective evaluation of the following four traits: balance, structural correctness, breed and sex characteristics, and degree of muscling. See AQHA rulebook for further details. Not VHSA rated.

AQHA Western Horsemanship Classes – Western attire only. This is a patterned class. Exhibitors will be worked from the gate individually. The whole class, or just the finalists, must work all three gaits at least one direction on the rail. Exhibitors are scored from 0-100 with 70 denoting an average performance. Judged on exhibitor's overall poise, confidence, appearance and position throughout the class, as well as the physical appearance of the horse. See AQHA rulebook for further details. Not VHSA rated.

AQHA Hunter Seat Equitation Classes – This is a patterned class. Exhibitors will be worked from the gate individually. The whole class, or just the finalists, must work all three gaits at least one direction on the rail. Exhibitors are scored from 0-100 with 70 denoting an average performance. Judged on exhibitor's overall poise, confidence, appearance and position throughout the class, as well as the physical appearance of the horse. See AQHA rulebook for further details. Not VHSA rated.

AQHA Western Pleasure Classes – Open to all ages. Horses 6 years old and older must be shown in bit. Horses 5 years old and under may be shown in either a bit, hackamore or snaffle bit. This class will be judged on the performance, condition and conformation of the horse at the discretion of the judge. 20% of the judging shall be based on condition and conformation. Horses to be shown at a walk, jog, and lope both ways of the ring on a reasonably loose rein without undue restraint. A moderate extension of the jog is required in at least one direction. At the option of the judge, horses may be asked to extend the jog or lope both ways of the ring. Must back easily and stand quietly. Horses are to be reversed to the inside. They may be required to reverse at the walk or jog at the discretion of the judge, but shall not be asked to reverse at the lope. See AQHA rulebook for further details. Not VHSA rated.

Quarter Horse Walk/Trot Pleasure 10 & Under – Open to exhibitors 10 & under showing a registered Quarter Horse. To be shown at a walk and trot/jog only both ways of the ring. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability and conformation. Not VHSA rated.

AQHA Hunter Under Saddle Classes – Horses to be shown under saddle but not to jump. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Horses should back easily and stand quietly. Judges should emphasize free movement and manners. Judged on performance, condition, and conformation. At the option of the judge, all or just the top 12 horses may be asked to hand gallop at one time. No more than 12 horses to hand gallop at one time. At the hand gallop, the judge may ask the group to halt and stand quietly on a free rein. See AQHA rulebook for further details. Not VHSA rated.

AQHA Trail Classes – This is a western class. Course to include a minimum of 6 obstacles, 3 of which are mandatory. Horses shall be penalized for any unnecessary delay while approaching or negotiating the obstacles. Horses must not be required to work on the rail: however, course to be designed for horses to show the three gaits between obstacles. To be judged on performance of the horse over obstacles, with emphasis on manners, response to the rider and quality of movement. Mandatory obstacles include: (1) Opening, passing through and closing gate, Losing control of gate is to be penalized. (2) Ride over at least four logs or poles. These can be in a straight line, curved, zigzag or raised (See AQHA rulebook for spacing); and (3) backing through obstacle - backing through and around three markers, or grounds poles in the shape of a L, V, U, etc. Optional obstacles include a water hazard with no slick bottom; serpentine obstacles at walk or jog, to carry an object from one part of arena to another (only objects which might reasonably be carried on a trail ride); crossing wooden bridge 3' x 6'; to put on and remove slicker; remove and replace material from mail box; sidepass around or through obstacle; 360 turn in square; or any other safe and negotiable obstacle that could reasonably be expected to encounter on a trail ride. Unacceptable objects such as tires, animals, hides, PVC pipe, dismounting, jumps, flames, dry ice, fire extinguisher, etc. See AQHA rulebook for further details. Not VHSA rated.

Open Walk/Trot Pleasure – Open to any Beginner, Novice Rider, or Green Horse/Pony in all seats. To be shown at a walk and trot/jog both ways of the ring for manners, performance, and suitability. Not VHSA rated.

Adult Western Pleasure/Adult English Pleasure - Open to any rider 19 and over. To be judged at a walk, trot or jog, and canter or lope both ways of the ring for manners, performance, and suitability. Class may be combined into one Adult Pleasure class pending entries. Not VHSA rated.

Open Quarter Horse Pleasure Championship – Open to any exhibitor that showed in a Quarter Horse Western Pleasure or Quarter Horse Hunter Under Saddle class that day. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog, and canter/lope both ways of the ring for performance, condition, and conformation. Must back easily and stand quietly. Not VHSA rated.

Open Walk/Trot Pleasure Championship – Open to any Beginner, Novice Rider, or Green Horse/Pony exhibitor that competed in a walk/trot only pleasure class that day. To be shown at a walk and trot/jog only both ways of the ring. Judged on manners, performance, quality, and substance. Exhibitors must halt and stand quietly. May be asked to back. Not VHSA rated.

Open Pleasure Horse Championship – Open to any Junior, Senior, or Adult exhibitor that competed in a pleasure class that day. To be shown at a walk, trot/jog, and canter/lope both ways of the ring for manners, performance, and suitability. Exhibitors must halt and stand quietly. May be asked to back. Not VHSA rated.

Didn't place in a class?? We don't want you to go away empty handed!

All exhibitors who don't place in a class will have their name entered in a drawing for a chance to win door prizes at the end of the day. Grooming supplies, tack, free classes at a future show, who knows what the prize might be? Maybe even cold hard cash! The winning names will be drawn by our judge after the last class. Must be present to win prize.
